



PLATES, WEDGES & MORE

Supply List

This class was inspired by the wide variety of options that can be found using the **22.5 degree wedge** ruler and the **Kaleidoscope** ruler from Nifty Notions. You might think you've seen it all but WOW - these options are too much fun! Because you have so many choices in size and style of work the fabric requirement is difficult.

For background you will need approximately 1/3 yard for every three 12" blocks you would make. So if you wanted 12 blocks you would need 1 1/3 yd of background. They can be scrappy but you will need to be able to get your chosen size square from the pieces you bring. To simplify, if you want to make 4 blocks that are 12" then you will need to bring 2/3 yard of background fabric - assorted mediums to equal 1/2 - 3/4 yards and 1 yard of a dark for borders. If you have a variety of fabrics you have been collecting to make a quilt then bring that collection and you'll have more choices.

In addition to your fabric requirements you will need to bring any special tools you like to have on hand, all rotary cutting equipment, sewing machine in good working order.

Also 22.5 wedge ruler from Nifty Notions (available in class) Kaleidoscope ruler from Nifty Notions (available in class) Any Kaleidoscope ruler will work, but the wedge must be the above ruler in order to partner for some of the blocks. If you don't own either, then wait for the demo and make your decision about which rulers to own.
