



## QUILT A

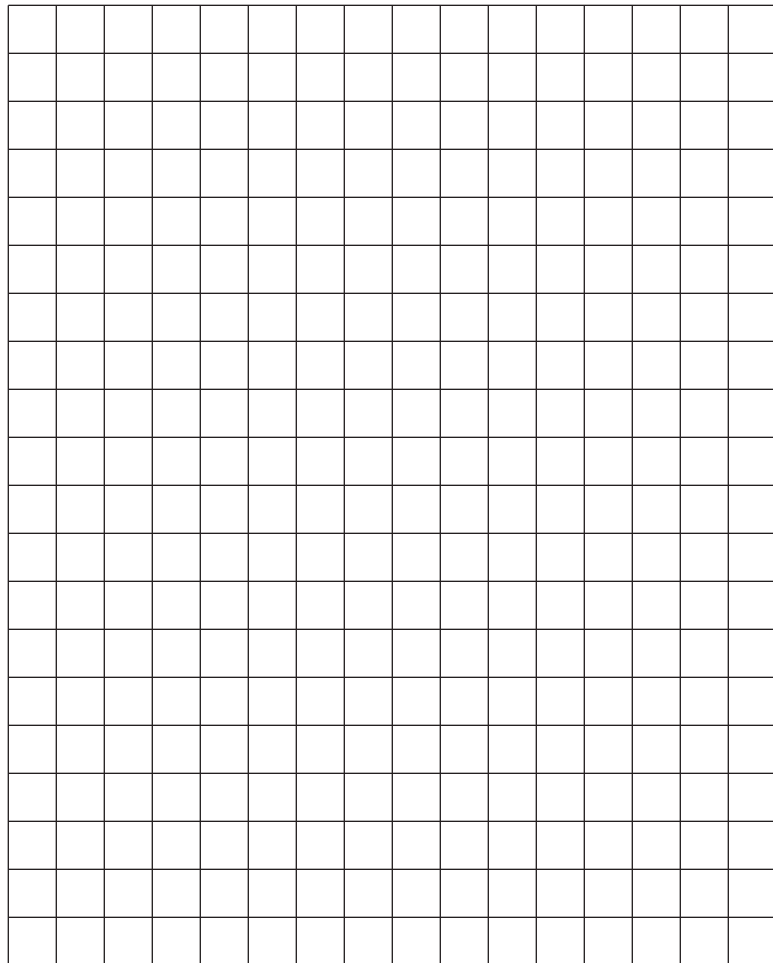
Cut all your pieces into 7" x 22" strips and cross cut all into 7" squares. Sew in rows: 8 blocks wide by 10 blocks long. (80 blocks)  
This yields a quilt approximately 52" x 65" without borders.

NOTE: 7" strips will yield 99 blocks and we only used 80 so this could be made larger or use the remaining pieces for border options.

## QUILT B

Cut all your pieces into 4" x 22" strips and cross cut all into 4" squares. Sew in rows: 16 blocks wide by 20 blocks long (320 blocks).  
This yields a quilt approximately 56" x 70" without borders.

NOTE: 4" strips will yield 330 blocks and we only used 320 so again you could enlarge this quilt by one row wide and one row long or use for borders.



## QUILT C

Cut all your strips into 4" x 22" and select 8 darks and 8 medium or lights (could be scrap) to make the stars. The remaining units will form the base as does Quilt B. Stars can be random in their placement just being sure the same dark does not fall beside a star. Play with this placement and only add 7 or 9 if you prefer.

The star triangle units would be cut laying the two fabrics right sides together and cutting your sets with the half square ruler. Star placement is random and only requires that you have enough dark points to form the star. All from the same size strip set.

NOTE: 4" strips will yield fewer squares because you will be cutting triangle sets from a determined number.

\*Depending on how your cuts are made you may get fewer units but could add another fabric or decrease any of the quilts a row in either direction.
