



Strippie Supply List

This workshop will contain lots of tips and techniques for planning and executing this nostalgic setting. Your choice could include a set of antique or unused blocks (any size will work) or you will be given patterns to make your own blocks. If you come to class with some blocks more time can be spent on the setting styles and varieties. Prepare to be impressed with all the options you will have to work with when you finalize your setting.

If you are bringing a set of blocks you should also include enough fabric for the setting blocks. Not knowing if you will choose a diagonal set or straight set, I recommend you bring 2 yds of your setting choice and it is also a good idea to bring one or two other fabrics suitable as a blender, perhaps an inner border. You can use scraps to make the setting strips as well. The type blocks you work with will most likely determine the type of set you will use, straight or diagonal. A stripe fabric works well for the setting strips as does a large busy floral, much like the chintz florals used in the earlier strippies. In addition to fabrics for settings, please bring fabrics for piecing blocks if you are not arriving with finished blocks. I would recommend a background, main and two or three accents.

In addition to the above bring to class:

- sewing machine in good working condition
- rotary cutting equipment
- large square ruler and any special rulers you like at hand
- sewing basket, pins, ripper, etc.
- notebook and pencil
- camera (to remember the ones you want to do later,
