



RMS Titanic Supply List

We'll pay homage to the tragedy of 1912 when the Titanic sank and over one thousand five hundred people lost their lives. Many options on settings and piecing will be covered.

This block is the same block that was used in the tile for the main ballroom floor of the Titanic. It is the same block that we traditionally know as the 'Doris's Delight Block' as can be seen in Voices of the Past. We will be piecing using connectors or the Bias Rectangle Ruler

Please do not pre-cut anything prior to class as you may change your mind of the size block you will be doing. My quilt is 16 12" blocks using a variety of blue fabrics with different backgrounds. I used 16 blues and 16 beige/creams. If you make yours this way I recommend you bring a variety of scraps based on the color you choose. Any color will work in this quilt.

If you make 16 blocks with different darks and lights you will need

1/8 yd of each light and dark fabric or fat quarters will work well. If you are going to use the same print and same background you could get by with 1 1/2 yd of each.
