

Class Supply List

A variety of quilt patterns from the past will be discussed, all with the focus of working with reproduction fabrics to create an “old” looking quilt. You can of course use any style of fabric you choose. I love working with scraps and this allows you considerable freedom to do so. If in doubt about your fabric choices, just bring lots of stuff and we’ll make it work. If you are choosing a stripe I recommend three yards to allow more options. Most importantly, this class is for anyone that loves fabric. In addition to your fabrics, you will need the following supplies; Our focus will be of studying blocks that represent famous women from our past.

Fabric Requirements

- Main fabric - 3 yds (If in doubt, bring more)
- Two or three light, medium or dark accent fabrics - 1/2 yd each
- Background fabrics - 3 yds

Just be relaxed about your choices

Please DO NOT pre-cut any of your fabrics as we will work on quick techniques for our hands-on class.

In addition to the fabrics, you will need:

- Voices of the Past II book
- Sewing machine in good working condition
- all rotary cutting equipment, mat, rulers, cutter
- any basic sewing supplies you like to have on hand when you work
- reducing glass (optional)
- value seeker (red glass-optional)
- notebook/pencil
- camera (to remember those other great quilts)

Specialty Rulers

- Half Square (NNHS)
- Quarter Square (NNQS)

Rulers can be purchased from your local quilt shop.

Most importantly is to come to class prepared to learn new and easier ways to piece old favorites.
