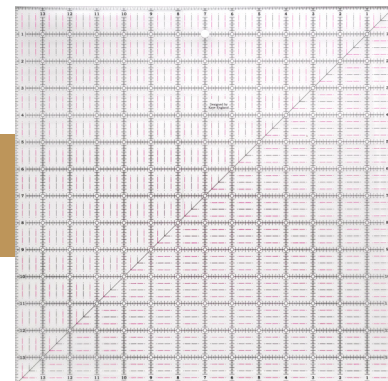


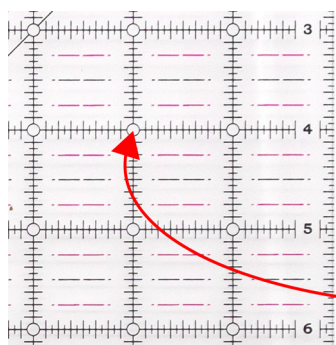

14" x 14" Square Ruler



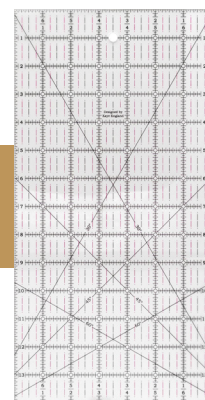
What the 14" Square ruler does:



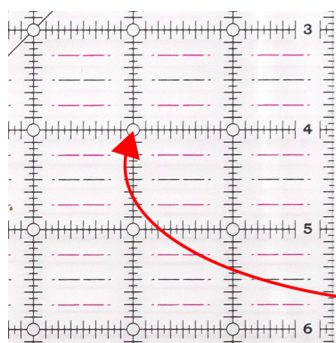
Clear Position Circle

A square ruler is used to make straight cuts, to create pieces, or to square-up completed blocks. Kaye England rulers make it easy for right- or left-handed users to position the tool on the fabric. Abundant SIGHT LINES assure accurate fabric placement under the ruler. Notice the Clear Position Circle at the intersection of each line. Be sure the fabric is centered under the circle to give you accurate cuts every time!

What the 7" x 14" Rectangle ruler does:



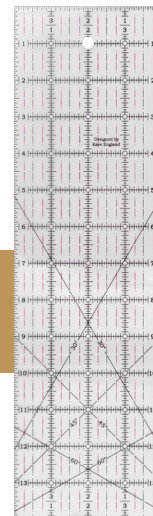
Clear Position Circle

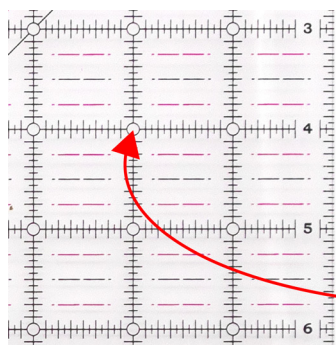
